



U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter

Purpose

The AYSO volunteer position of U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter is intended to work with the Regional Coach Administrator to recruit players for U-19, U-16, and U-14 boys teams.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

The U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter is expected to:

1. Get a list of all U-19, U-16, and U-14 boys players immediately following the second early registration session;
2. Get a list of last year's U-19, U-16, and U-14 boys players;
3. Review with the Regional Coach Administrator how many boys are registered for each division and establish recruiting goals;
4. Enlist support of registered players to recruit other players; and
5. Follow up on recruiting leads until teams are filled.

Qualifications and Desired Skills

To be considered for the position of U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter, the applicant must:

1. Annually submit an AYSO Volunteer Application form;
2. Pass the AYSO screening and background check;
3. Be annually approved and duly appointed as a U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter by the Region;
4. Have strong communication skills.

Supervision Protocols

While performing as the U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter, the volunteer is:

1. Subject to the bylaws, rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and guidelines of AYSO;
2. Under the overall authority of and directly supervised by the Regional Coach Administrator; and
3. To maintain the recommended adult to child supervision ratio of 1:8 or less; that is one adult for every eight or fewer children and two adults (one of whom may be the coach and one of whom should be of the same gender as the group) present at all times. For the protection of both the children and the volunteer, no volunteer should permit himself or herself to be alone with any child or group of children (except his or her own) during AYSO-sponsored activities.

Time Commitment

Time commitment will vary depending on Region size and length of playing season(s). For the typical AYSO Region, the U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter will devote about 8-10 hours per week during the season.

Orientation, Training, Certification, and Continued Education Provided

To fully prepare for the position, the U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter is expected to participate in the following training, certification and continuing educational opportunities:

1. Orientation by the Regional Commissioner – 1 ½ hours.
2. Orientation by the Regional Coach Administrator.
3. AYSO's Safe Haven – 2 hours.

Activity Locations

While performing the duties of U14 - U19 Boys Recruiter, the volunteer is limited to the following locations, unless expressly authorized in writing by the Regional Commissioner to hold or participate in activities in another location.

1. Regularly scheduled and duly approved inside or outside AYSO activities; and
2. Independent work at home alone, in committees of adults, or in a properly supervised situation with children.
