



## Soccerfest Worker

---

### Purpose

The AYSO volunteer position of Soccerfest Worker is intended to work with the Soccerfest Coordinator to organize Regional soccerfests

### Specific Duties and Responsibilities

The Soccerfest Worker is expected to:

1. Compile participating teams registration;
2. Schedule and prepare the fields;
3. Purchase awards and sales items (pins, T-shirts, etc.);
4. Coordinate with snack shack coordinator to provide refreshments;
5. Telephone participating team representatives;
6. Compute and display standings; and
7. Announce winners and distribute awards.

### Qualifications and Desired Skills

To be considered for the position of Soccerfest Worker, the applicant must:

1. Annually submit an AYSO Volunteer Application form;
2. Pass the AYSO screening and background check;
3. Be annually approved and duly appointed as a Soccerfest Worker by the Region;
4. Be familiar with AYSO tournament guidelines; and
5. Be dependable, organized and work well with others.

### Supervision Protocols

While performing as the Soccerfest Worker, the volunteer is:

1. Subject to the bylaws, rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and guidelines of AYSO;
2. Under the overall authority of and directly supervised by the Soccerfest Coordinator and indirectly, the Regional Commissioner; and
3. To maintain the recommended adult to child supervision ratio of 1:8 or less; that is one adult for every eight or fewer children and two adults (one of whom may be the coach and one of whom should be of the same gender as the group) present at all times. For the protection of both the children and the volunteer, no volunteer should permit himself or herself to be alone with any child or group of children (except his or her own) during AYSO-sponsored activities.

## **Time Commitment**

Time commitment will vary depending on Region size and length of playing season(s). For the typical AYSO Region, the Soccerfest Worker will devote about 8-10 hours per week during the season.

## **Orientation, Training, Certification, and Continued Education Provided**

To fully prepare for the position, the Soccerfest Worker is expected to participate in the following training, certification and continuing educational opportunities:

1. Orientation by the Regional Commissioner – 1 ½ hours.
2. Orientation by the Soccerfest Coordinator.
3. AYSO's Safe Haven – 2 hours.
4. Tournament Talk workshop at the annual Section Meetings.

## **Activity Locations**

While performing the duties of Soccerfest Worker, the volunteer is limited to the following locations, unless expressly authorized in writing by the Regional Commissioner to hold or participate in activities in another location.

1. Regularly scheduled and duly approved inside or outside AYSO activities; and
2. Independent work at home alone, in committees of adults, or in a properly supervised situation with children.
